Scholarship Application Information and Instructions

- Applicant must be a current graduating senior of any public or private HIGH SCHOOL.
- Applicant, or parent or guardian, must be a member in good standing of a Teamster Local Union affiliated with Teamsters Joint Council 32; or a member on lay-off status who has a valid withdrawal card, has recall rights and was in good standing at the time of lay-off; or a retired, disabled or deceased member of an affiliated Local who was in good standing in his or her Local Union at the time of retirement, disablement or death.
- Academic eligibility is based on a "B" average or better. (2.0 in a 3.0 grade point system; 3.0 in a 4.0 grade point system.) Winners are selected by lot.
- Submit only one application. Duplicate entries will be disqualified.
- Send your completed application, official High School transcript bearing the official school seal and two letters of recommendation (one from a former teacher) to the Local Union indicated on page one.
- Home-schooled students are required to submit an official copy of their SAT or ACT scores or the
 applicant may have the testing agency forward a copy of the test results.
- The application must be postmarked by April 30 of the current school year.
- · Only award winners will be notified.
- Scholarship winners are responsible for notifying the Scholarship Committee of any college choice changes at hoidahll@teamstersjc32.org by July of each qualifying scholarship year. If the committee is not informed, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- Scholarship is to be used for students taking a full-time credit load of 12 credits per semester.
